

Concerned about the eventual closure of County Road 91 at Grey Road 31?

We care about you, our neighbours. We care about traffic safety. And we want you, the community, to get where you need to go.

Here are some of the features of the road agreement:

Before the closure County Road 91 at Grey Road 31:

- ✓ 26/27 Sideroad will be upgraded from a seasonal road, maintaining local travel for immediate residents to and from parts of Grey Highlands, such as Osprey Heights, to and from Clearview/Stayner/Collingwood
- ✓ The upgraded 26/27 Sideroad will be fully maintained for year-round west-east and east-west travel
- ✓ The 10th Concession will be reconstructed and paved a longstanding wish for residents in the area

Other considerations:

- ✓ Heavy trucks will not be permitted to use the 26/27 Sideroad or the 10th Concession
- ✓ Walker will pay \$7.5 million for area road upgrades to improve local traffic
- ✓ County Road 91 will be reconstructed to meet Clearview Township standards
- ✓ County Road 91 will not be closed until the 26/27 Sideroad upgrade is complete
- ✓ County Road 91 will accomodate local community traffic
- ✓ County Road 91 will be a local road managed by Clearview Township and its roads crews
- ✓ Any traffic from outside the community will be able to continue to use County Road 124 to and from Collingwood and Stayner

The road works will begin only when all Expansion Quarry License approvals and conditions have been met.
